ARTICLE 3

Everyone must work towards what is best for a child.



ARTICLE 6

Every child has the rights to life, survival & development.



ARTICLE 23

If a child lives with disability, she/he needs care & support to live a full life.



ARTICI F 32

Child must be safe from work that harms them or threatens their education.



ARTICLE 28

All children have the right to a free & fair education.



ARTICLE 29

Education should develop a child to participate fully in his/her community.

第3條 任何人都應以兒童的 最大利益為先。



第6條 兒童有生存和發展 的權利。



第23條 如兒童有殘疾·必須得 到特別照顧·讓他們亦 有充實的生活。



第28條 所有兒童都應得到免費 及平等的教育。



第29條 教育應協助兒童發展及 充分融入社會。



第32條 兒童有權不參與一些 傷害他們或影響他們 學業的工作。
