







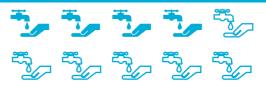


# Our goals in 2030

## Why water & sanitation are relevant to child rights?

United Nations
Convention on the
Rights of
the Child

Clean water, basic toilets and good hygiene practices are essential for the survival and development of children.



## **ARTICLE 2**

No matter what race, religion or family unit, a child have rights under the Convention.



## **ARTICLE 6**

Every child has the rights to life, survival & development.



### **ARTICLE 24**

Good health, clean water & nutritious food are a child's right.



### **ARTICLE 27**

All children must have their basic needs met, no matter how disadvantaged or marginalized.



### ARTICLE 28

All children have the right to a free & fair education.



## **ARTICLE 32**

Children must be safe from work that harms them or threatens their health.



## Actions to take





Reduce water consumption, e.g. spend less time in the shower.



Protect the water sources. Do not discharge waste into rivers or oceans.



Initiate a clean-up project for rivers, seasides and oceans. Invite the people in your community to join the campaign.



Raise public awareness on the clean water and sanitation issues through social media. Voice out for the people who are lack of clean water and toilets.
