Why peace, justice & strong institutions are relevant to child rights?

Peace, stability, human rights and effective governance are central to the realization of child rights.

United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child



ARTICLE 6

Every child has the rights to life, survival & development.



ARTICLE 8

A child must have an identity and an official record of it.



ARTICLE 19

Laws must protect children from being hurt or mistreated.



ARTICLE 24

Good health, clean water & nutritious food are a child's right.



ARTICLE 38

Children should be protected from war. Those 15 years and younger must not serve in armed forces.



ARTICLE 39

Children who have been hurt, neglected or badly treated need special care and help.



Actions to take

Raise the awareness on birth registration by organizing a school workshop. Let your schoolmates know what problems facing children without birth registration.



Protect children from abuse and exploitation. Be a responsible consumer by purchasing fair trade products.

Promote peace with your creativity, e.g. design a peace slogan and share it through social media.

和平、穩定、人權和有效管治是實現兒童權利的關鍵。

聯合國 兒童權利 公約



第6條

兒童有生存和發展的權利。



第8條

兒童應有正式登記的身份。



第19條

法律須保護兒童免受傷害或虐待。



第24條

健康的身體、清潔食水和有營養的食物，都是兒童的權利。



第38條

兒童應在戰爭中受到保護；15歲以下兒童不應加入軍隊。



第39條

遭傷害、忽視或虐待的兒童，必須得到特別照顧和幫助。



你可以做甚麼？

16 和平與公義



透過舉辦學校工作坊，提高學生對出生登記議題的認識。讓同學知道沒有出生證的兒童有可能面對的問題。



保護兒童免受虐待和剝削。成為一個負責任的消費者，並購買公平貿易的產品。



隨時隨地為任何形式的暴力行為發聲。



運用創意來推廣和平訊息，例如設計一個有關和平的口號，並透過社交媒體與大眾分享。
