Actions to take





Reduce carbon footprint for a more sustainable environment, e.g. ride on bike or walk.



Promote the natural heritage of Hong Kong. Take photos without destroying the environment, and share the beautiful views on social media.



Promote the concepts of child-friendly and inclusive playgrounds. Organize workshop for children in your community. Let them voice out and create their ideal playgrounds.



Reduce waste by recycling and upcycling, e.g. place recycling bins on the floor you live and encourage your neighbours to use them.

你可以做甚麼?





減少碳足跡以促進可持續的環境,例如騎單車或步行。



推廣香港的自然遺產,例如在不破壞環境前提下拍照,並透過社交媒體分享美麗的景色。



推廣兒童友好和共融遊樂場的概念。為社區的兒童組織工作坊,讓他們表達意見,創造 其理想的遊樂場。



透過回收和升級再造來減少浪費, 例如:在你居住的樓層放置回收箱, 並鼓勵鄰居使用它。
