ARTICLE

Every child has the rights to life, survival & development.



ARTICI F 8

A child must have an identity and an official record of it.



ARTICI F 19

Laws must protect children from being hurt or mistreated.



ARTICLE 24

Good health, clean water & nutritious food are a child's right.



ARTICLE 38

Children should be protected from war. Those 15 years and younger must not serve in armed forces.



ARTICLE 39

Children who have been hurt, neglected or badly treated need special care and help.



Actions to take





Raise awareness on birth registration by organizing a school workshop. Let your schoolmates know the problems children without birth registration are facing.



Protect children from abuse and exploitation. Be a responsible consumer by purchasing fair trade products to lower the risks of children and labour exploitation.



Raise your voice against all forms of violence, anytime and anywhere.



Promote peace with your creativity, e.g. design a peace slogan and share it on social media.

聯合國 **兒童權利** 公約



第6條 兒童有生存和發展 的權利。



第8條 兒童應有正式登記 的身份。



第19條 法律須保護兒童免受傷害 或虐待。



第24條 健康的身體、清潔食水和 有營養的食物· 都是兒童的權利。




第38條 兒童應在戰爭中受到保護; 15歲以下兒童不應 加入軍隊。



遭傷害、忽視或虐待的兒童,必須得到特別照顧和 幫助。



你可以做甚麼?







透過舉辦學校工作坊,提高學生對出生登記 議題的認識。讓同學知道沒有出生證的兒童 有可能面對的問題。



保護兒童免受虐待和剝削。成為一個 負責任的消費者,選購公平貿易產品, 減低兒童及勞工被剝削的風險。



願意站出來,向任何形式的暴力行為說不。
